The journal is meant to publish articles that make original contribution to general issues in research, education and biblical studies with emphasis on well researched empirical studies, and with a view of promoting excellence in Nigerian secular and theological education.

However, review articles that present the state of the art of specific areas of other areas of research as well as position papers on contemporary issues shall also be accepted. Scholarly and original articles from allied disciplines that have spiritual and educational values are welcomed.

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- 1. The editorial board of International Journal of Education and Biblical Studies (IJEBS), a publication of Crown Theological Seminary, Enugu, Enugu State Nigeria, an Affiliate of University of America, California, USA, will consider for publication in the subsequent issues of the journal, on a variety of high quality manuscript on issues relating to any filed of education and biblical studies. Although theoretical and philosophical papers are welcomed, more emphasis will be placed on empirical research work.
- Intending authors should send in three copies of each article intended for publication, accompanied by a processing/vetting fee payable to the business editor. Articles are received throughout the year.
- 3. Article submitted to the journals should be scholarly and original contributions of author(s) and should not be under consideration for any other publications at the same time. Articles should not be more than eighteen pages on A4, double spaced typing on one side of the page only (including abstract and references) with Times New Roman, Font Size 12.. Tables and figures should be keep to the barest minimum and should be include in the text. All tables and figures should be properly captioned and numbered serially throughout the text.
- 4. Each article should be arranged as follows:
 - i. Title of the article, name of the author(s) and affiliation(s) all on the same page.
 - ii. Title of the articles, and abstract of not more than 150 words followed by the main body of the article.

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- iii. The body of the article should not exceed 16 pages of A4 paper, typed double spacing in Times New Roman, Font Size 12.
- 5. Quotations of more than 39 words (40 and above) should be indented.
- 6. References should follow the latest APA style. Endnotes and footnoting are not allowed.
- 7. Ideas expressed in the articles are personal to the contributors. As such, the authors are responsible for the views they expressed. Contributors should obtain written permission to use materials for which they do not have copyright.
- 8. Article sent for publications will be subjected to experts' review and only those found publishable by assessors will be published in the journal.
- 9. The Editorial Board will not enter into correspondence with authors whose articles are not found publishable.
- 10. Contributors should enclose two self-addressed stamped envelopes for return post, include email and phone number for easy reach.
